Lahny R. Silva is a professor of law at Indiana University Robert H. McKinney School of Law where she teaches criminal law, criminal procedure, and criminal sentencing. Her scholarship focuses on reentry and the collateral consequences of conviction. Professor Silva currently works with the federal REACH team in the Southern District of Indiana where she supervises a mentor-advocate program for newly released probationers. Prior to joining the faculty at McKinney, she was the William H. Hastie Fellow at the University of Wisconsin Law as well as a legislative appointee for the State of Wisconsin Special Committee on Review of Records Access of Circuit Court Documents. Immediately after law school, she worked as a staff attorney for Greater Hartford Legal Aid practicing in the areas of housing, family law, and criminal record expungement.
